## LESSON 1— Jesus Loves the Lost!

- Scripture:** Luke 15:1-7; John 10:1-18; 1 Peter 2:24-25
- Memory Verse:** Luke 19:10—“For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.”
- ESV:** Luke 19:10—“For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.”
- Teaching Objective:** The unsaved child will know that Jesus loves and welcomes him when he believes in Jesus as his Savior from sin.
- Main Teaching:** Jesus loves and welcomes sinners.
- Emphasis for Saved:** Rejoice when someone is saved!
- Word Up:** Jesus loves me!

## LESSON 2—Jesus Takes Away Sin!

- Scripture:** Luke 18:35-43; Mark 10:46-52; Luke 18: 31-34
- Memory Verse:** John 3:16—“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.”
- ESV:** John 3:16—“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.”
- Teaching Objective:** The unsaved child will believe on Jesus to take away the darkness of sin.
- Main Teaching:** Jesus came to take away the darkness of sin.
- Ephasis for Saved:** Praise God for taking away your darkness of sin..
- Word Up:** Jesus takes away sin!

### **LESSON 3—Only Jesus Satisfies!**

- Scripture:** John 6:1-15, 22-71; Mark 6:30-44
- Memory Verse:** John 3:16—“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.”
- ESV:** John 14:6—“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.”
- Teaching Objective:** The unsaved child will believe in Jesus, who will satisfy his need to know Jesus and the eternal life He gives..
- Main Teaching:** Jesus came to satisfy your need for Him!
- Emphasis for Saved:** Trust Jesus to satisfy the needs of your heart—spend time with Him.
- Word Up:** Only Jesus satisfies!

### **LESSON 4—Jesus Has Power over Death!**

- Scripture:** John 11:1-46
- Memory Verse:** John 11:25—“I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live.”
- ESV:** John 11:25—“Jesus said to her, ‘I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live.’”
- Teaching Objective:** The unsaved child will believe in Jesus, receiving His gift of everlasting life.
- Main Teaching:** Jesus has power over death.
- Emphasis for Saved:** You can hope in God no matter what happens!
- Word Up:** Jesus has all power!

### **LESSON 5—Put Your Faith in Jesus!**

- Scripture:** John 4:46-53
- Memory Verse:** John 11:25—“I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live.”
- ESV:** John 11:25—“Jesus said to her, ‘I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live.’”
- Teaching Objective:** The unsaved child will put his faith in Jesus alone for salvation.
- Main Teaching:** Put your faith in Jesus alone to save you from sin.
- Emphasis for Saved:** God wants you to live by faith.
- Word Up:** I can put my faith in Jesus!
