# **God's Sovereignty: The Life of Joseph**

## LESSON 1—Joseph: Born into a Family of Promise (Topical Evangelistic)

**Scripture:** Genesis 12:2-3; 29:18—30:24; 35:9-21

Memory Verse: Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD,

thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end."

**ESV:** Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope."

**Teaching Objective:** The saved child will trust that God is always at work in his life and God will keep His promises.

Main Teaching: God is always at work to keep His promises.

Emphasis for Unsaved: Receive the Lord Jesus, the promised Redeemer, and become part of God's

family.

Word Up: God keeps His promises!

## LESSON 2— Joseph Sold by His Brothers (TCE 2 Flex)

Scripture: Genesis 35:21, 27-29; 37:1-35

**Memory Verse:** Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end."

**ESV:** Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope."

**Teaching Objective**: The saved child will trust God's sovereign care even when he doesn't understand what God is doing.

Main Teaching: God is in control even when you don't understand.

**Emphasis for Unsaved**: Believe on Jesus as your Savior and become His child.

Word Up: God is in control!

#### **LESSON 3—Joseph Experiences God's Help** (Topical Growth)

Scripture: Genesis 39; Psalm 105:16-19

**Memory Verse**: Joshua 1:9 "Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest."

**ESV:** Joshua 1:9 "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."



**Teaching Objective**: The saved child will know that God is with him always and cares for him.

Main Teaching: God is with you and cares for you.

**Emphasis for Unsaved**: Believe on the Lord Jesus and be saved.

Word Up: God is with us!

## LESSON 4— God Rewards Joseph— (TCE 2)

Scripture: Genesis 40—41

**Memory Verse**: Joshua 1:9 "Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest."

**ESV:** Joshua 1:9 "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do

not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

**Teaching Objective**: The saved child will be comforted because God knows what He is doing.

Main Teaching: God knows everything. You can trust Him.

Emphasis for Unsaved: Trust in Jesus for salvation!

Word Up: I can trust God!

### **LESSON 5**—Joseph: God's Plan Revealed (TCE 1)

**Scripture**: Genesis 42—45; 46:5-7, 28-30; 47:11-12; 50:15-21

**Memory Verse**: Ephesians 1:7a "In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of

sins."

ESV: Ephesians 1:7a "In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses."

**Teaching Objective**: The unsaved child will believe on Jesus for forgiveness of sin, recognizing that God

kept His promise to send a Savior.

**Main Teaching**: God offers forgiveness through the promised Savior. **Emphasis for Saved**: God will work all things together for your good.


Word Up: God forgives!
