Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will realize God's justice requires sin's punishment and accept God's mercy through Jesus Christ.

Main Teaching: God offers mercy to all sinners.

Emphasis for Saved: God is faithful to keep his promises.

Word Up!: God is merciful

LESSON 3— The Judges: Rebellion and Rescue Repeated (Doctrinal Growth)

Scripture: Judges 2; 3:31; 4; 5:4, 20-21; 13:1-5; 15:9-15; 16:16-30; 21:25

Memory Verse: "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding." (Proverbs 3:5)

ESV Memory Verse: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding." (Proverbs 3:5)

Teaching Objective: The child will recognize that sin has consequences and choose to experience victory over sin by God's grace.

Main Teaching: God has the power to give you victory over sin in your life.

Emphasis for Unsaved: God can rescue you from the power and punishment of sin.

Word Up!: God gives victory!

life.

Main Teaching: God wants to use you for His good work!

Emphasis for Unsaved: Jesus took the punishment your sin deserves!

Word Up!: God can use me!
