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LESSON 1—The Gold Page: God's Perfect World (Topical Evangelistic)

Scripture: Genesis 1-2, Revelation 21-22

Memory Verse: John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."

ESV Memory Verse: John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will believe that God desires to have fellowship with him and that God made a way for him to be restored to God's original design.

Main Teaching: God wants to have a friendship with you!

Emphasis for Saved: God is actively involved in your life.

Word Up!: God is so good!

LESSON 2—The Dark Page: Man Ruins God's Perfect World (TCE 1 Evangelistic)

Scripture: Genesis 2:15-3:24

Memory Verse: John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."

ESV Memory Verse: John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will believe in Jesus, the only one who can redeem him.

Main Teaching: Believe in Jesus, who can free you from sin!

Emphasis for Saved: God knows the best way to live!

Word Up!: God made a way!

LESSON 3—The Red Page: Jesus is God's Promised Messiah! (Doctrinal Evangelistic)

Scripture: Gen 22:16-17; Mat 1:18-25, 4:1-11, 26:1-5; Luke 1:26-38, 2:1-21, 2:41-52, 23:34; John 19—20:10

Memory Verse: John 3:17 "For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved."

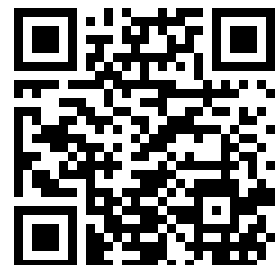
ESV Memory Verse: John 3:17 "For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him."

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will believe in Jesus, God's promised Messiah, who died and rose again so he could be saved.

Main Teaching: Believe in Jesus, God's promised Savior!

Emphasis for Saved: I can trust the Bible is true!

Word Up!: The Bible is true!



LESSON 4— The Clean Page: Jesus Changes Me! (Doctrinal Growth)

Scripture: Luke 19:1-10; John 14:26; Romans 5:10; 1 Corinthians 3:16; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Ephesians 2:13; Colossians 1:19-22

Memory Verse: John 3:17 “For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.”

ESV Memory Verse: John 3:17 “For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.”

Teaching Objective: The saved child will rely on the benefits of salvation that result in a change in his life.

Main Teaching: When you believe on Jesus your life is different.

Emphasis for Unsaved: Jesus took your sin on Himself.

Word Up!: My life can be different!

LESSON 5—The Green Page: God’s Word Helps Me Grow (Topical Growth)

Scripture: 1 Samuel 3; 2 Chronicles 34; Proverbs 3:13-18; Luke 2:41-52

Memory Verse: Psalm 119:160 “Thy word is true from the beginning: and every one of thy righteous judgments endureth forever.”

ESV Memory Verse: Psalm 119:160 “The sum of your word is truth, and every one of your righteous rules endures forever.”

Teaching Objective: The saved child will desire to know more about who God is and what He says about life.

Main Teaching: God knows the best way to live!

Emphasis for Unsaved: Believe on Jesus, God’s way of salvation.

Teaching Statement: God’s way is best!
