

## Jesus: God Who Cares for People

### LESSON 1— Jesus Shows He Is the Almighty God (Evangelistic Doctrinal)

**Scripture:** John 2:1-11

**Memory Verse:** “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” (John 3:16)

**ESV Memory Verse:** “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.” (John 3:16)

**Teaching Objective:** The child will recognize that Jesus is the almighty God who came to redeem lives.

**Main Teaching:** Believe Jesus is the almighty God, your Redeemer!

**Emphasis for Saved:** Believe Jesus is the almighty God. Praise Him.

**Word Up!:** Jesus is the almighty God!

### LESSON 2— Nicodemus Can't Save Himself (TCE 1 Evangelistic)

**Scripture:** John 3:1-16

**Memory Verse:** “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” (John 3:16)

**ESV Memory Verse:** “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.” (John 3:16)

**Teaching Objective:** Children will recognize they are dead in sin and only Jesus can make them alive again.

**Main Teaching:** Only Jesus can give me new life.

**Emphasis for Saved:** The Holy Spirit will change your heart and help you do good.

**Word Up!:** Jesus gives new life!

### LESSON 3— Jesus Loves Everyone (TCE 1 Evangelistic)

**Scripture:** John 4:1-30, 39-42

**Memory Verse:** “For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.” (John 3:17)

**ESV Memory Verse:** “For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.” (John 3:17)

**Teaching Objective:** The unsaved child will believe on Jesus, who knows and loves him.

**Main Teaching:** Jesus knows you and loves you.

**Emphasis for Saved:** Ask the Holy Spirit to help you love people who are hard to love.

**Word Up!:** Jesus loves everyone!

#### **LESSON 4— Jesus Heals the Nobleman’s Son** (TCE 1 Evangelistic)

**Scripture:** John 4:46-54

**Memory Verse:** “He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.” (John 3:36)

**ESV Memory Verse:** “Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.” (John 3:36)

**Teaching Objective:** The unsaved child will believe on Jesus as the only Savior from sin.

**Main Teaching:** Believe on Jesus, God the Son, to save you from sin.

**Emphasis for Saved:** Believe what God has promised you in His Word.

**Word Up!:** Believe God’s promises!

#### **LESSON 5— Jesus Cares for Bartimaeus** (TCE 1 Evangelistic)

**Scripture:** Mark 10:46-52; Luke 18:35-43

**Memory Verse:** “He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.” (John 3:36)

**ESV Memory Verse:** “Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.” (John 3:36)

**Teaching Objective:** The unsaved child will trust Jesus to forgive his sin.

**Main Teaching:** Only Jesus can take away your darkness of sin.

**Emphasis for Saved:** Praise God for the good things He does for others.

**Word Up!:** Praise God for His mercy!

#### **LESSON 6— Creation Celebration** (Review Lesson)

Children will enjoy this “Guess Who?” party as they review what they’ve learned in the *Jesus: God Who Cares for People* series. Since this series has covered specific people Jesus cared for, children can play several games to “guess who” the characters were. This is also a great time to teach the children God is a personal God who knows their every thought and need. God doesn’t play “guess who?” with people!
