

The Patriarchs: God's Plan Unfolds

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LESSON 1—The Tower of Babel (Growth Narrative)

Scripture: Genesis 11:1-9

Memory Verse: “Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God.” (1 Corinthians 10:31)

Teaching Objective: When praised, the saved child will glorify God by telling others what God has done for him.

Main Teaching: Live your life to bring glory to God.

Emphasis for Unsaved: Believe in Jesus, not yourself, for salvation from sin.

Word Up! Give glory to God!

LESSON 2—Abram's Saving Faith! (Evangelistic Doctrinal)

Scripture: Genesis 12:1-9; Romans 4:3, 11-21

Memory Verse: “Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God.” (1 Corinthians 10:31)

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will put his faith in Jesus alone to be saved.

Main Teaching: Faith is trusting in Jesus alone to be saved.

Emphasis for Saved: Depend on the Holy Spirit to help you live by faith every day.

Word Up!: Trust in Jesus alone!

LESSON 3—God is Faithful to Keep His Promises (Growth Narrative)

Scripture: Genesis 12:2; 15:1-6; 17:1-7, 15-19; 18:1-15; 21:1-7; Romans 4:3

Memory Verse: “Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it.” (1 Thessalonians 5:24)

Teaching Objective: The saved child will repeat Hebrews 13:5b to himself when in hard situations, remembering God keeps His promises.

Main Teaching: Depend on your faithful God to keep His promises!

Emphasis for Unsaved: Trust God, who is faithful, to keep His promise to save you if you believe in Jesus as Savior.

Word Up! God is faithful!

LESSON 4—God Gives a Picture of the Promised Savior (Evangelistic Narrative)

Scripture: Genesis 22:1-14; Hebrews 11:17-19

Memory Verse: “But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name.” (John 1:12)

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, God’s provision for his salvation.

Main Teaching: God has provided a Savior for you.

Emphasis for Saved: Trust God even when it is hard.

Word Up! God provided the Savior!

Visual Aids: Flashcards 3-5; 4-1—6

LESSON 5—God Changes Jacob (Evangelistic Narrative)

Scripture: Genesis 25:19-34; 27:1-28:5, 10-22

Memory Verse: “But as many as received him, to them gave he the power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name.” (John 1:12)

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will trust Jesus to change him from the inside out by believing in Him as his personal Savior from sin.

Main Teaching: Jesus can change you from the inside out.

Emphasis for Saved: Trust God’s sovereign control in your life.

Word Up! Jesus can change me!

Visual Aids: Flashcards 5-1—6

LESSON 6— Jacob and Esau Are Reunited (Growth Narrative)

Scripture: Genesis 29:1-30; 31:3, 17-18; 32:3-32; 33:1-4, 18-20; 35:1, 9-15, 27-29

Memory Verse: “Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God.” (1 Corinthians 10:31)

Teaching Objective: The saved child will look for godly character traits that the Lord is building into his life, even through difficult circumstances.

Main Teaching: God wants to make you more like Jesus.

Emphasis for Unsaved: Before you can be changed to be more like the Lord Jesus you need to know Him as your Savior.

Word Up! God makes me new!
