God Speaks to Me - Rhyming Reviews for CEF Curriculum

(These reviews coincide with the review questions at the end of each lesson.)

Instructions: The purpose for rhyming reviews is to utilize a creative way of restructuring the review questions into rhymes where the class can fill in the answer with a rhyming word. It is an adaption from a former game called "Ralph the Rhymer."

For example: Fill in the rhyming word in this sentence.

God's <u>salvation</u> is for every (nation). Or the victory is <u>won</u> in God's (Son).

Children do much better by answering as a class for the rhyming review. It also gives confidence to those who come close to getting the answer. They are immediately a part of the whole group with the right answer. Some reviews will have a double set of rhyming words.

Lesson One: God Speaks to Me Through Creation

- 1. Before Job even came to be, God had already made the earth and the sky and the sea.
- 2. God is so creative with all of His creatures in the ocean of <u>course</u>. Just look at the amazing seahorse.
- 3. God gives great attention to detail, as His creation will <u>show</u>.

Just look at one flake of His amazing snow.

4. God knows all about you and me and the birds that sing.

Yes, He knows about everything.

- 5. When you gaze into the sky, whether cloudy or <u>blue</u>, always remember that God loves <u>you</u>.
- 6. When God first created the world for all to see, it was perfect for Adam and for Eve.
- No longer perfect, the world they were <u>in</u>, for Adam and Eve disobeyed God. They chose to <u>sin</u>.
- Sickness, sadness and death is the way it has <u>been</u> ever since people have chosen to <u>sin</u>.
- Jesus dying for our <u>sins</u> and coming to life <u>again</u> is God's amazing <u>plan</u> to save every boy, girl, woman and <u>man</u>.
- 10. Just as God gives us new spiritual <u>birth</u>, for the world, he will make a new <u>earth</u>.
- 11. God is making the New Earth for those who have trusted in <u>Jesus</u>, the only One who saves us from sin and <u>frees us</u>.
- 12. The heavens tell us about God's glory so we will want to know more of His story.

Lesson Two God Speaks Through Jesus

- 1. God sent an angel to talk with Mary. He told her that God's Son, she would carry.
- 2. Saving people is Jesus' claim. "The Lord Saves" is the meaning of His name.
- 3. We need a rescue. We need God to win. We need to be saved from our sin.
- 4. Jesus' miracles of healing the lame, raising the dead and giving sight to the <u>blind</u> show that Jesus has compassion, is good and <u>kind</u>.
- 5. Through Jesus we can learn so much about <u>God</u>. He is perfect and all-powerful. If you know He loves you, can you <u>nod</u>?
- 6. When people saw evil men arrest Jesus, beat Him, spit on Him and put a crown of thorns on His head, they asked, "<u>Why</u>?" Then the evil men nailed Jesus to a cross to <u>die</u>.
- Why, oh why, did Jesus die? To take the punishment for our <u>sin</u> so that our hearts, He could <u>win</u>.
- 8. After Jesus rose again, the first to come and see, was a lady named, Mary.
- Before returning to Heaven, what did Jesus' promise <u>say</u>? For all who believe in Him, He would come back <u>someday</u>.
- 10. When in Jesus you <u>believe</u>, eternal life you will <u>receive</u>.
- 11. If in Jesus you <u>believe</u> and God's love you <u>receive</u>, you can love even those who try to <u>deceive</u>.
- 12. If Psalm 19:1 you can say, then glory to God, you can pray.

Lesson Three God Speaks Through His Word Part One

- 1. What were some ways the kings of Israel and Judah <u>disobeyed</u>? They neglected His temple and ignored His Word while with idols they worshipped and <u>played</u>.
- 2. By harming their bodies, where God's Spirit dwells, ignore His Word and love other things more than God, believing boys and girls <u>today</u>, can still <u>disobey</u>.
- 3. When a kingly crown Josiah did take, he was only a boy at the age of eight.
- Josiah was different than the other kings and hardly could be <u>bored</u> because he did what was right in the sight of the <u>Lord</u>.
- 5. How can you know how God wants you to <u>live</u>? Read His Word and pray. The answer He will <u>give</u>.
- When Josiah's men were fixing the temple, do you know what they <u>saw</u>? A part of the Bible: a book of the <u>law</u>.

- After Josiah read the Word of God what did he <u>do</u>? Called all the people together so that he could read it to them, <u>too</u>.
- 8. To live more like God is a change the Holy Spirit can <u>make</u>. He does all this for Jesus' <u>sake</u>.
- 9. To die for our sins, Jesus is the only <u>One</u>. That's because He is God's perfect <u>Son</u>.
- After hearing God's Word what did the people <u>do</u>? They destroyed their idols, that's a <u>clue</u>.
 They chose to worship the one true Creator God, what about <u>you</u>?
- 11. To be saved from the punishment of sin, believe on Jesus whom God <u>sent</u>. Being willing to turn from sin and live God's way is to <u>repent</u>.
- 12. God's Bible, the Scripture is inspired. Of its teaching and instruction we'll never get tired.

Lesson Four God Speaks Through His Word Part Two

- 1. The Bible writers tell of God's power and <u>might</u>. It took 1,600 years to <u>write</u>.
- 2. Jeremiah followed God's command to give a message to the people of God's land.
- 3. Jehoiakim was Josiah's son, the next in line to be the king. Yes, he was the one.
- If you have believed in Jesus as your Savior, and God's Word you want to <u>understand</u>, God's Holy Spirit will help you. He is the One who <u>can</u>.
- 5. When the scroll was read to King <u>Jehoiakim</u>, he got angry and threw it into the fire. His anger resulted in a <u>sin</u>.
- 6. God protected His Word from Jehoiakim's angered <u>sin</u> and told Jeremiah to write it down <u>again</u>.
- God gave the Bible through the ages past so people could worship and <u>learn</u>. Now it is our <u>turn</u>. We can also read, worship and <u>learn</u>.
- 8. Deserve death? You and I? Because we have sinned, that's why.
- 9. God does not want to give you death and strife. His plan for you is eternal life.
- 10. What did Jesus do to take the punishment for your sin? What does the Bible <u>say</u>? He died on the cross and rose again on the third <u>day</u>.
- 11. The gift of eternal life can be <u>received</u>. Jesus is the only one who can take away our sins. For this, we must <u>believe</u>.
- 12. If II Timothy 3:16-17 you can guote, then many good reasons you'll remember why God spoke.

Lesson Five God Speaks. Are You Listening?

- Hannah was sad when she went to God's house that <u>day</u>. She still had no baby for which she had come to <u>pray</u>.
- A promise to God, Hannah made, this <u>way</u>: If God would give her a son, she would bring him back to serve and <u>stay</u>.
- Thoughts, actions and attitudes that go against God are done by all <u>men</u>. It's just a three letter word called, <u>sin</u>.
- 4. "Samuel, Samuel," a voice called. Then Samuel's reply, "Did you call me, Eli?"
- After three times, Eli got a <u>clue</u>. Then he told Samuel just what to <u>do</u>. "Lay back <u>down</u> and the next time <u>around</u>, when you hear the Lord's voice <u>sound</u>, say, "Speak, Lord, for your servant hears."
- Required is no special <u>title</u>. To those who have received Jesus as Savior, God speaks through the <u>Bible</u>.
- Our memory verse reminds us of what the Bible will <u>do</u>. That's to equip us in every way for God's good works through and <u>through</u>.
- 8. When Samuel listened to God, he listened <u>well</u>. God gave him a sad message for Eli that he would have to <u>tell</u>.
- 9. When you read a command in God's Word, what should you <u>say</u>? "I'm listening Lord. I will <u>obey</u>."
- 10. The hard message for Eli that Samuel had to tell, for he could not <u>lie</u>, was that his sinning sons would surely <u>die</u>.
- 11. Because of Jesus we can be forgiven of our sin. It is because He died for us and rose again.
- 12. When we believe on the Lord Jesus to be saved, the punishment for our sin is placed on Him.
