LESSON 1—Jesus Teaches with Power (Topical Evangelistic)

Scripture: Hebrews 1:1-2; Matthew 4:23-25; John 10:22-30; 14:1-6; Mark 1:21-22; 7:1-9

Memory Verse: Matthew 6:9 “After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.”

Teaching Objective: The children will learn that Jesus has the power and authority to teach them about God.

Main Teaching: You can know God through Jesus.

Emphasis for Saved: You can enjoy close friendship with God.

Word Up!: I can know God through Jesus!

ESV: Matthew 6:9 “Pray then like this: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.”

LESSON 2—Jesus Calms a Terrible Storm (TCE 2 Growth)

Scripture: Mark 4:35-41

Memory Verse: Matthew 6:10 “Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.”

Teaching Objective: The saved child will trust that God has the power to do what is good and best in his life.

Main Teaching: Jesus is the all-powerful God. You can trust Him!

Emphasis for Unsaved: Jesus has power to save you from sin.

Word Up!: Trust Jesus—He’s all powerful!

ESV: Matthew 6:10 “Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.”

LESSON 3— Jesus Feeds a Huge Crowd (TCE 1 Evangelistic)

Scripture: John 6; Mark 6:30-44

Memory Verse: Matthew 6:11 “Give us this day our daily bread.”

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will believe that Jesus is the Savior and trust Him for salvation.

Main Teaching: Jesus came to make a way for you to have eternal life!

Emphasis for Saved: God wants you to trust Him for everything.

Word Up!: Jesus is the Savior!

ESV: Matthew 6:11 “Give us this day our daily bread,”



LESSON 4—Jesus Offers Hope to a Samaritan Leper (TCE 1 Evangelistic)

Scripture: Luke 17:11-19; Leviticus 13:45-46; 14:1-2

Memory Verse: Matthew 6:12 “And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.”

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will believe that Jesus is his only hope.

Main Teaching: Jesus is your only hope for salvation.

Emphasis for Saved: Thank God for what He has done for you.

Word Up!: Thank God—Jesus is my hope!

ESV: Matthew 6:12 “and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.”

LESSON 5—Jesus Explains His Awesome Plan (Doctrinal)

Scripture: Matthew 16:13-17; 17:1-9

Memory Verse: Matthew 6:13 “And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.”

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will trust in Jesus as his Savior and King.

Main Teaching: Jesus has power to save you from sin and rule your life.

Emphasis for Saved: Jesus is God—Listen to Him.

Word Up!: Jesus is the one true God!

ESV: Matthew 6:13 “And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.”
