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LESSON 1—The Savior Is Born! (Evangelistic Narrative)

Scripture: Matthew 1:19-25; Luke 1:26-38; Luke 2:1-20

Memory Verse:

KJV “For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ the Lord.” (Luke 2:11)

ESV “For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.” (Luke 2:11)

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will believe that Jesus came to be his Savior from sin and accept His forgiveness.

Main Teaching: Jesus is the Savior God promised to send.

Emphasis for Saved: Tell others that Jesus came to be their Savior.

Word Up! God keeps His promises!

LESSON 2—Wise Men Worship the Savior King (Evangelistic Narrative)

Scripture: Matthew 2:1-23; Luke 2:39-40

Memory Verse:

KJV “For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ the Lord.” (Luke 2:11)

ESV “For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.” (Luke 2:11)

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will believe that Jesus is the Savior who, by God’s plan, came to die for the sins of the world.

Main Teaching: Jesus is King, your Savior.

Emphasis for Saved: Worship the Lord Jesus as your King.

Word Up!: Jesus is King!

LESSON 3—Jesus Obeys His Heavenly Father (Growth Narrative)

Scripture: Luke 2:40-52

Memory Verse:

KJV “For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure.” (Philippians 2:13)

ESV “for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.” (Philippians 2:13)

Teaching Objective: The saved child will ask the Holy Spirit for strength to obey God, thanking Him for His help.

Main Teaching: Follow Jesus' example of obedience.

Emphasis for Unsaved: Your first step in following Jesus is to become His child by receiving Him as your Savior.

Word Up! Obey God!

LESSON 4—Jesus Is the Promised Savior (Evangelistic Narrative)

Scripture: Matthew 3:1-6, 13-17; Luke 1:5-24, 39-45, 57-65; John 1:26-29; Luke 3:1-22

Memory Verse:

KJV "For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure." (Philippians 2:13)

ESV "for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure." (Philippians 2:13)

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will trust in the Lord Jesus as his Savior.

Main Teaching: Only Jesus can save you.

Emphasis for Saved: Point others to Jesus.

Word Up! Only Jesus saves!

LESSON 5—Jesus Is the Sinless Savior (Doctrinal Growth)

Scripture: Matthew 4:1-11; Luke 4:1-13; Romans 5; Hebrews 2; 4

Memory Verse:

KJV "For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succour them that are tempted." (Hebrews 2:18)

ESV "For because he himself has suffered when tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted." (Hebrews 2:18)

Teaching Objective: The saved child will rely on the Holy Spirit and the Word of God to obey when tempted.

Main Teaching: Jesus can help you obey God when you are tempted.

Emphasis for Unsaved: Call on the Lord Jesus to save you from sin.

Word Up! Jesus wins!

LESSON 6— Happy Birthday Review Party

Celebration! This review party has a birthday theme to celebrate Jesus' birth and also the new birth everyone can have when they trust in Jesus as their Savior. This time can also be used to celebrate the birthdays of all the kids! Feel free to go all out with the decorations and theme or keep it simple. Use the games and activities to build relationships with the children. There are many games to choose from. Pick the activities that work best for your club dynamic. Make sure you include both the Gospel Spotlight and the Growth Spotlight in your schedule.
