## Lesson Five: Jesus is the Sinless Savior

### Character Review

**Courage** is conquering fear in order to assist or help others.

*Courage inspires decisiveness, initiative, boldness. A lack of courage brings fear.\**

When Jesus was led into the wilderness by God the Holy Spirit, he exercised **courage**. He was not alone. God the Holy Spirit was with Him. He was not without knowledge. He knew the solid truth of God's words, the Scriptures. He also knew His purpose for coming to earth, to seek and to save the lost by being the sinless Savior.

Going through a time of testing would prove that He is God the Son, able to say no to temptation. He did it by speaking the truth right from the Word of God. As a result, He is able to come to the aid of all of us who are tempted. He is able to forgive us because of His payment for our sin and coming back to life. Post 5 signs around the room from page 56. "Afraid of the dark, Sad, Needing Help, Sin, Temptation."

Have team leaders read the 5 different verses with different clubbers, listed with this wonder activity, and try to match the verse with the need. Choose a clubber to retrieve the matching card when the clubbers guess the match. When they get a match, comment and encourage their comments about why it is a good match.

Narrative: Just like these verses are great matches for common situations in our lives, Jesus used the perfect verses to give an answer when He was tempted. Let's find out in our lesson today what verses He used.

### Rhyming Review

1. Satan used to be an angel of light, but he failed to worship the true God of all power and might.
2. Then, Satan tempted Adam and Eve and led them to disbelieve. But God had a plan to save all people so His Son they could receive.
3. Satan would tempt Jesus and try to get Him to sin, too. But he failed when Jesus answered with God's Word. There was nothing Satan could do.
4. When you are tempted and want to sin, remember what God's Word says, that Jesus can help you and that He wants you to win over sin.
5. Jesus' great victory for us was when He died on the cross for our sin and then came back alive again.
6. Jesus proved His power and purity when tempted and did not sin, making Him able to come to the aid of children, women and men.
