### Lesson 1 Jesus Forgives the Sin of the Paralyzed Man

---

**Scripture:** Luke 5:17-26

**Supporting Scripture:** Matthew 9:1-8; Mark 2:1-12

**Memory Verse:** “But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power upon earth to forgive sins.”  
(Luke 5:24a)

**Teaching Objective:** The unsaved child will find forgiveness in the saving work of Christ.

**Main Teaching:** Jesus has the power to forgive your sins.

**Emphasis for Saved:** God can use you to show His love to others by helping them.

**Word Up!:** Jesus forgives sin!

**Visual Aids:** Flashcards 1-1—6

**Lesson Type:** Evangelistic Narrative

### Lesson 2 Jesus Calms a Terrible Storm

---

**Scripture:** Mark 4:35—5:1

**Supporting Scripture:** Matthew 8:18, 23-27; Luke 8:22-25

**Memory Verse:** “Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you.  
Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.” (John 14:27)

**Teaching Objective:** The unsaved child will trust in the mighty God to have his sins forgiven and have a relationship with God.

**Main Teaching:** Jesus is the only one who has the power to save you from your sin and give you a friendship with God.

**Emphasis for Saved:** Jesus has power to give you peace over any problem you face.

**Word Up!:** Jesus is all powerful!

**Visual Aids:** Flashcards 2-1—6

**Lesson Type:** Evangelistic Narrative

## Lesson 3 Jesus Shows Love to a Samaritan Woman

---

**Scripture:** John 4:1-30, 39-42

**Memory Verse:** “I am the Lord, and there is none else, there is no God beside me.” (Isaiah 45:5a)

**Teaching Objective:** The unsaved child will believe on Jesus, who knows and loves him.

**Main Teaching:** Jesus knows you and loves you.

**Emphasis for Saved:** Ask God to help you love others—even people who are hard to love.

**Word Up!:** Jesus loves everyone!

**Visual Aids:** Flashcards 3-1—6

**Lesson Type:** Evangelistic Narrative

## Lesson 4 Jesus Heals the Centurion’s Servant

---

**Scripture:** Luke 7:1-10; Matthew 8:5-13

**Memory Verse:** “Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.” (Acts 4:12)

**Teaching Objective:** The unsaved child will believe in Jesus, the only one with the authority to forgive sins.

**Main Teaching:** Jesus is the only one who can save you from your sin.

**Emphasis for Saved:** You can trust Jesus has the power to do what He says He will do.

**Word Up!:** Jesus keeps His word!

**Visual Aids:** Flashcards 4-1—6

**Lesson Type:** Evangelistic Narrative

## Lesson 5 Jesus Challenges a Rich Young Man

---

**Scripture:** Mark 10:17-27

**Memory Verse:** “Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.” (Acts 4:12)

**Teaching Objective:** The unsaved child will trust Jesus as Savior, realizing salvation is through Jesus alone.

**Main Teaching:** Trust Jesus alone for eternal life.

**Emphasis for Saved:** Value Jesus above everything else.

**Word Up!:** Trust Jesus!

**Visual Aids:** Flashcards 5-1—6

**Lesson Type:** Evangelistic Narrative
