MY QUIET TIME

A Quiet Time is a special time set aside each day for the purpose of getting to know God better and better.

SUGGESTIONS



1. Set aside a regular time DAILY.
2. Have a quiet heart and a quiet place (Psalm 46:10a).
3. Be prepared. Have a Bible, notebook, and pencil.
4. Before reading the passage, pray for understanding of God's Word and a heart attitude ready to receive His truths (Psalm 119:18).
5. Expect God to teach you something each day from His Word (Psalm 119:105).
6. Talk with God and worship Him.
7. If you fail to have a Quiet Time, confess it to God and begin again (Proverbs 24:16).

BIBLE STUDY _____

The Bible is God's true and living Word through which He guides you in all areas of your life (2 Timothy 3:15-17).

1. Start simple
The book of Mark is a great place to start. It is easy to read and tells of the life of the Lord Jesus.

TAKE-HOME PROJECT


Photocopy this page and mount on cardstock, one for each child.

Prayer Requests for God: The One to Follow series

Lesson 1-Peter Meets Jesus

-Lord, help each child grow in the grace and the knowledge of their Lord and Savior. May they live for Your glory both now and forever. Amen!

-Father, if any of the kids do not know You as Savior, may this be the week they see their need and receive Your great gift of salvation.

-May the children understand that You made them with all with their strengths, weaknesses, and differences. May they believe You want to use each of these things for Your glory and purposes.

-When the saved kids fail and sin, may they quickly confess their sin and believe that You are faithful and just and will forgive that sin.

-May the unsaved kids recognize their sin and be burdened to repent.

-May the children recognize Your love and patience in their life, and may it lead to a life fully committed to serve You in any circumstances.

Lesson 4-Peter Learns the Gospel is for Everyone

-Lord, stir in these young hearts and raise up missionaries obedient to go where You send them.

-May each child understand You love each tribe, language, and people group and desire them to be around Your throne someday. Give the kids that same love and value for them.

- May the kids understand that every people group's greatest need is Jesus- they need the Gospel.

- Make each child a bold witness for You, beginning now. Give them a heart for the lost.

Lesson 5- Peter and Rhoda

-Lord, help the kids understand You hear and answer prayer. May they witness the power of prayer and get excited to bring their problems, questions, and thanksgiving to You.

-May the kids understand they can pray specifically for needs.

-Make each individual become a prayer warrior for life. May their prayers be sweet incense to You.
